


## AIRWORTHINESS ADVICE NOTICE

- TYPE AFFECTED:** All sailplanes and powered sailplanes operated under GFA regulations.
- SUBJECT:** Glider Maintenance Release Part 3.
- BACKGROUND:** The current GFA maintenance release was developed for safe and airworthy operations of sailplanes in common clubs in Australia. For professional operators or big clubs with their own record system, Part 3 of the maintenance release may not be necessary since the relevant data is recorded somewhere else and arising actions (inspections, engine overhauls etc.) are carried out appropriately.
- ACTION REQUIRED:** In order to be exempted from using Part 3 of the current GFA maintenance release written application with the CTO (A) has to be made. Compliance with the purpose of Part 3 - awareness of maintenance duties during daily inspections - must be shown. The achieved safety standard of any other record system must be at least equivalent to the GFA maintenance release Part 3.
